The European Image and Sound Association has just awarded the Pro-Ject Audio "The Classic" best turntable for 2016/17. At under \$2000 this could be a desirable upgrade for someone with an entry level model like the Debut range. Details below.

I mentioned last month that we had the fabulous Whatmough Signature 15 stand mount speakers available for demonstrations, well we still do, and they are now on permanent demonstration as we have decided to keep them as our personal main loudspeakers in our lounge room. As a special offer till the end of the year we will include a pair of Apollo 500mm speaker stands in the price.



Rotel is a brand that I remember from the 70s, in fact they have been going since 1961, and still offer solidly built, reliable, and value-for-money equipment. They have just released a new range, designated 14 Series. More info below.

A reminder, next weekend is the <u>Australian Hi Fi & AV Show</u> in Melbourne, at The Rialto, from Friday to Sunday. There's over 40 demonstration rooms so if you have an interest in high fidelity sound and have never been to one of these shows it is a great opportunity to hear a wide variety of brands at a single venue. It's well worth the \$21.00 admission for the time it saves you compared to trying to get around to individual dealer showrooms. A real earopener! I'm not involved as an exhibitor this year. Next year's show will be in Sydney 28-30th July, 2017.
